Logo Design Specifications

The Logo Design will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Clarity of message related to Ngalipaku (*All of Ours*)
- Visual impact
- Reproducibility (on website and documents)

Required design elements:

- Reflect "*All of Ours*"
- Note:** The Ngalipaku Youth Services logo should reflect an *inclusive* community in Menzies.

Technical requirements for Submission

- Artwork can be produced by any means you like
 - Where submission is electronic, acceptable file formats and resolution requirements are: JPEG, TIFF, EPS, PDF
 - 300 dpi minimal resolution
 - No MSWord or Powerpoint Files

Note: We will use the logo in a wide range of sizes from 1cm up to 2 metres. This makes it a challenge to design a clear, readable image. A good test of your design is to print it on A4 paper and check that you can read it from 3 metres away. Please respect copyright of other artists. If you copy an image, illustration, photo or icon from a book, website, CD/DVD or other source without permission you are infringing copyrights or someone else's work. Please make your own, based on the idea that inspired you.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By signing the Entry Form each participating artist agrees to be bound by the following **Terms and Conditions of Entry**:

1. The Artwork must reflect the Ngalipaki (*All of Ours*) theme
2. All entries will be viewed by and judged by
 - a. Popular vote of visitors to the exhibit of artworks
 - b. Judges appointed by the Shire of Menzies
3. Where a participating artist is under the age of 18, the parent or guardian of the artist must complete the Entry Form by stating the name of the parent or guardian and on behalf of the artist, the artists name to indicate their agreement with these terms and conditions.
4. The decision of the judges will be final and absolute.
5. No correspondence about the decision will be entered into.
6. Property rights in all submissions, including the winning artwork will remain with the artist or entrant except as provided for by these conditions.
7. By signing the completed Entry Form, submitting an artwork and accepting the award offer, the winning artist:
 - a. grants to the Shire of Menzies, permanent, royalty-free, worldwide, irrevocable, ongoing, non-exclusive licence (including a right of sub-licence) to use, reproduce, communicate, broadcast, publish, distribute, adapt, modify the winning artwork in all media of expression now known or later developed and, in all languages, for any purpose specified in these terms and conditions.
 - b. Consents to any of the following types of acts or omissions by the Shire of Menzies;
 - i. Use of all or part of the art work in accordance with the licence granted above, with or without attribution of authorship to the artist (but the Shire will not falsely attribute authorship of the entry)
 - ii. Supplementing the art work with any other material; and
 - iii. Use of the art work in a different context⁶ to that originally envisaged;
 - c. May be requested to physically sign a licence and consent form relating to the artwork, prior to the competition being finalised. Failure to sign the licence will entitle the Shire to remove the artist's work from the competition.
 - d. Agrees that the Shire of Menzies may publish information provided by the artist in connection with their entry including, but not limited to, the artist's name, age, community and state/territory of residence and
 - e. Warrants that at the time of accepting the artwork there is not cultural or religious reason or any other impediment that prevents the artwork from being exhibited, published or reproduced.
8. The Shire of Menzies's purpose in using the art work is limited to the following purposes, and anything incidental to such purposes
 - a. Being used on all media relating to the Ngalipaku Building, Menzies Youth Services or Shire of Menzies Community Activities.
 - b. Being displayed in a public place
 - c. Incorporated into event notices and flyers
 - d. Providing black and white templates (for colouring in) to promote the Shire of Menzies recreational services
